One challenge with the resurgence of interest in the Puritans is . . . where to start!? Martyn Lloyd-Jones's well-researched biographical addresses were some of the most popular features of the conferences where he spoke - introducing people to the Puritan tradition from its origins in the Reformation to its successors in the nineteenth century. Written in an absorbing and stimulating style, Lloyd-Jones later adapted these addresses for a wider audience providing insight for the church today. Lloyd-Jones believed that the study of history is vital to the well-being of the contemporary church and draws lessons from major and minor Reformation, Puritan, and Great Awakening figu es.

Aimed at addressing the real questions of young adults, Cheeseman answers the fundamental questions about saving faith — what really saves us? Who turns the key in the locked door of the human heart — is it God or man? The answer to this question has profound consequences for evangelizing the world with confiden e and for living the Christian life without fear. John shows from Scripture that man's only hope is in the grace of God, that is, the grace of a God who actually does the saving and is the only true answer for those who can do nothing to save themselves... and that means everyone!

Owen wrote this polemical work to show that the doctrine of universal redemption is both unscriptural and ultimately destructive of the gospel. It is not a book for lazy thinkers who see no need for doctrinal exactness - or who find he title so shocking that they refuse to read it. Although the title of Owen's work famously uses the word 'death' three times, it is actually an amazingly positive work that gives hope to those despairing of assurance of salvation or who struggle to see God's intervention in this life. Owen will help you think through the issues that lead to the confident ecovery of the gospel of Jesus Christ.
